We work with volunteers ages 15 and up and follow a detailed process to ensure that we have the right role for each volunteer:

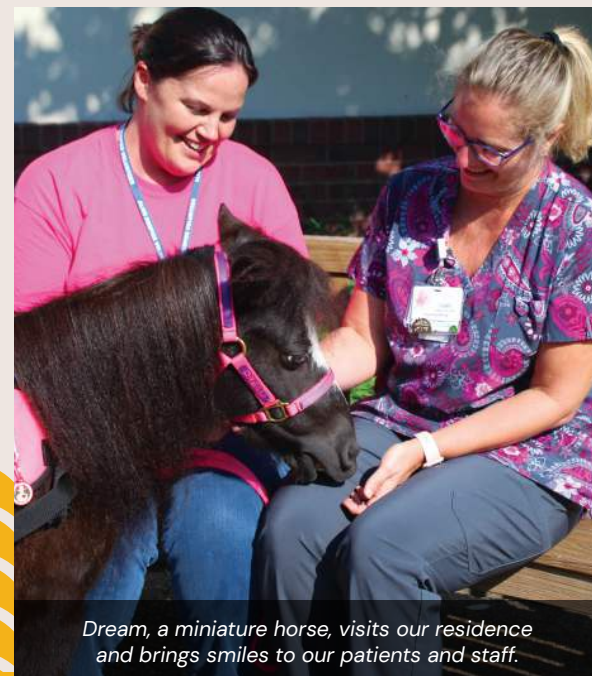
Step 1: Complete our Volunteer Application at AliveHospice.org/Volunteer
